THE SCHOOL CAMPUS : THE FACILITIES AND THE FACILITATORS

Spread over an area of 65,000sq. yards, the campus is modern, hi-tech and well-equipped for comfort, convenience and academic pursuits. This campus offers a large number of special opportunities for students. Apart from the lecture rooms, it has fully furnished Computer Labs, Music Rooms, Home Science & Design Labs, Science Labs, Psychology Labs, Studios for Fine Arts, VIRTUAL LIBRARY, SEMINAR ROOM & OPEN AIR THEATRE. A HI-TECH LANGUAGE LAB is the latest addition to the ever-growing campus.

The school is equipped with learning facilitators & gadgets ranging from Overhead Projectors, Slide Projectors, Xerox Machine, TV, VCR & Audio Players, Multimedia Projector and Multimedia CD ROMs. The school has a TECHNO CENTRE and a CENTRAL COMPUTING FACILITY for the faculty and the students. For conferencing, seminars, symposia & board meetings, the school has an air conditioned SEMINAR ROOM. The school offers HOSTEL accommodation with all the ultra modern amenities, lush green lawns and a peaceful atmosphere conducive for studies. The school offers a well-stocked multi storey LIBRARY, which has over 50,000 books and subscribes to 1800 online & 150 print journals, 17 newspapers and 65 popular magazines. The silver jubilee AUDITORIUM - URVI, is the centre of academic, co-academic and cultural activities like orientation camps, face-to-face shows, annual functions, and as preparatory ground for many items, related to performing arts. The SPORTS COMPLEX which is an impressive focal point of the players' activities, has facilities for all the games as well as for NCC and NSS. In the beautifully designed Shri Mohan Lal Arora YAJYASHALA, Havan is performed daily not only to purify the atmosphere but also to make the students aware of the Vedic Culture, our rich tradition and heritage. A multi-tiered PARKING BLOCK has also come up. The STADIUM with a seating capacity of 1,000 has also been constructed other than a GYMNASIUM and a MEDIA HOUSE. A multi-activity COMMON ROOM for students and a separate block for Music & Dance has also been constructed. A NEW BLOCK is built for the department of Commerce. Administration Block has been renovated completely.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- The parents are required to read the Prospectus before signing the form.
- Once the form is signed, the total responsibility of having read the rules and regulations shall lie upon them. The student should -
 - fill the form neatly and completely.
 - get it signed from her parents/guardian.
 - get it checked from the Subject Verification Board.
 - face interview conducted by the admission board, for seeking admission.
- Subjects will be given on FIRST COME FIRST SERVE CUM MERIT basis, and as per availability.
- Students who have been on the rolls in the previous year will lose their claim, on late arrival.
- Admitted students will pay the fee at the fee counter on the same day and deposit the form at the same counter.
- In case of delay in the payment of fees, the form will need re-validation by the incharge of Admission Board.
- The students should submit the photographs in the office to collect the identity card.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR FINAL EXAMINATIONS

Attendance in the mid-semester HOUSE TESTS is compulsory. The school will take strict disciplinary action against a student,

who is absent in the House Tests. However, the Principal may suspend punitive action in extraordinary circumstances.

The students are required to fulfil the following eligibility conditions for appearing in the final examinations of PSEB.

- a) Get 25 percent marks in aggregate of all the subjects .
- b) Attend 75 percent of the total lectures delivered, in each of the subjects taken by them, including theory and practicals.
- c) Clear all the dues of the school.

In case they fail to fulfil any of these conditions, they shall be detained from appearing in the final examinations of PSEB.

It is the responsibility of the students to apprise their parents of all the rules and regulations.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- Always carry your Identity Card (Entry without Identity Card in school is not allowed).
- Come to the school in proper uniform on Mondays, and wear decent dresses on other days.
- Don't litter the campus. Eatables are not allowed in the academic area and the auditorium.
- Don't scribble on the walls & the school property.
- Rush for the assembly as soon as the bell rings.
- Don't carry mobile phones in the school. Strict action would be taken against a student found guilty of using mobile in the classroom.
- Visit the Information Centre daily, and read all the notices.
- Attend the 'Havan', as and when notified; heavy fine will be levied for each absence.
- Don't honk the horn in the campus. Park your vehicles in proper parking and do not sit on the parked vehicles.
- Alight from the car, a little away from the main gate, if somebody comes to drop you, to allow the smooth flow of traffic.
- Avoid keeping heavy cash & jewellery in your bag.
- Don't indulge in ragging. RAGGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED AND PUNISHABLE BY LAW.
- Switch off the fans and lights while leaving the classrooms.
- Be regular and punctual in classes. Make use of your free time in academic/co-curricular pursuits.

Any student found guilty of misbehaviour/ disobedience shall be rusticated from the school.

However, admission will finally be made on Merit out of the applications received. For admission to 10+2, the applicant should have passed 10+1 Examination, from a school affiliated to PSEB.

Note:

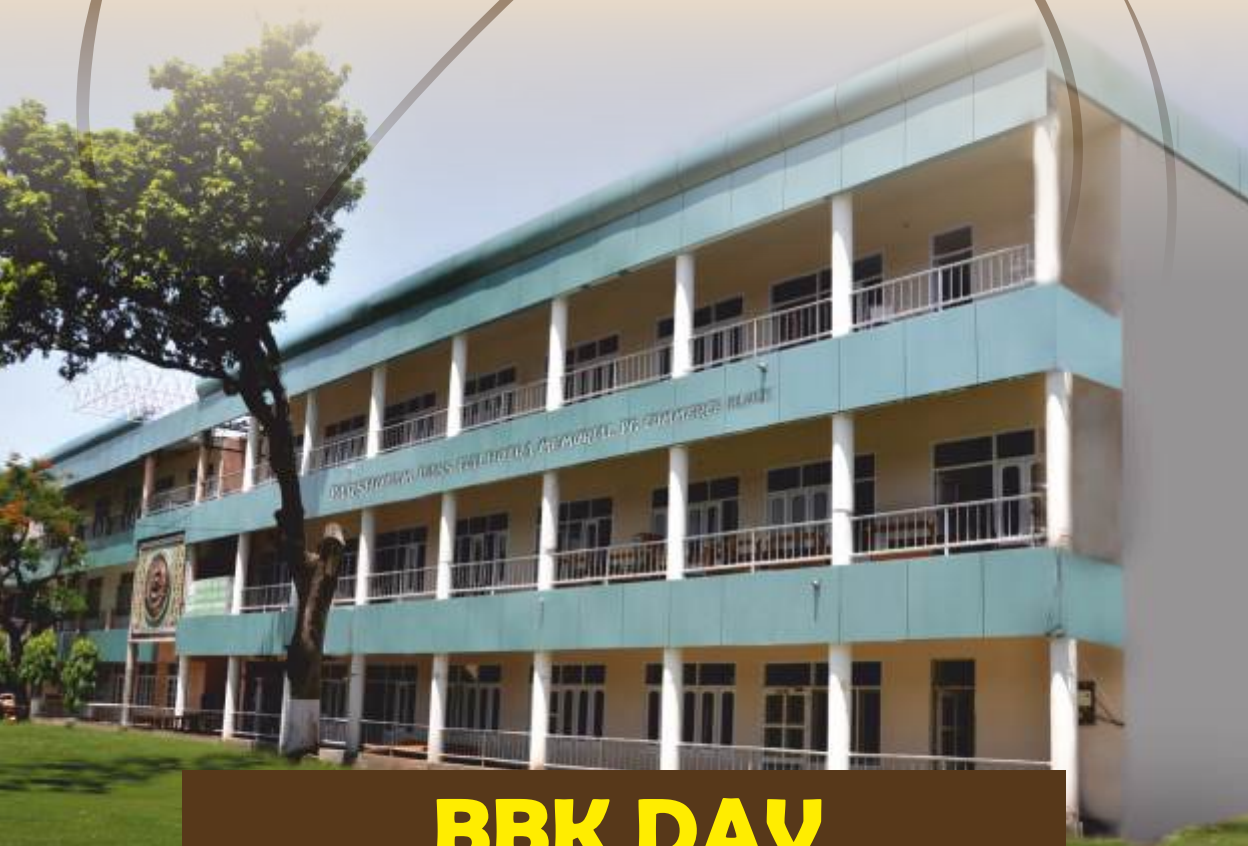
- General English, General Punjabi. Computer Science & Environmental Studies are Compulsory subjects.
